Regulations of subjects being conducted in the Department of Humanistic Sciences In Medicine

- 1. All classes take place according to the schedule in the hours provided for in the class schedule. The student is obliged to participate in classes with the student group to which he was assigned.
- 2. Before entering the classes, outer clothing should be left in the locker room.
- 3. Classes include seminars and exercises.
- 4. The lecturer at the first class presents detailed conditions of pass, in accordance with the syllabus of the subject.
- 5. Presence on exercises and seminars is obligatory. Three absences during the academic year are allowed (including one justified). In the case of blocked classes, only one absence is allowed.
- 6. In the case of three or more justified absences, the student is required to pass orally the content of the material or to take up classes with another group after prior appointment with the person running the subject. The student is obliged to make up for the absence in the same semester in which he missed the classes.
- 7. The person responsible for the subject after each semester will receive attendance lists and a list of students who have not fulfilled the above-mentioned conditions on the basis of which it is possible to pass the course.
- 8. Keep the order and cleanliness on the corridors and in the classrooms. Keep silence, during the classes. Smoking is forbidden. During the classes it is forbidden to eat meals.
